Five Little Kittens

(scamper fingers away)

Craft:

Coffee Filter Kitties (Inspired by: <u>https://www.lookwerelearning.com/coffee-filter-cat-craft/</u>) Materials:

- Coffee Filters
- Construction Paper
- Glue Sticks
- Crayons
- Small/medium paper triangles (ears and nose)
- Googly eyes (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Choose what color your kitty will be and color in the coffee filter.
- 2. Glue the coffee filter to your construction paper—this is the kitty's head.
- 3. Add two small triangles to the top of the coffee filter—these are kitty's ears.
- 4. Add the small pink triangle to the middle of the coffee filter—this is kitty's nose.
- 5. Now use your crayons to add facial details and more color to make your pretty kitty the perfect pet for you!
